March 14, 2018

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, March 14, 2018 at the Town Hall in Downsville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, Dennis Weber, John Miller, Sally Rasmussen and Arlene Cartwright

1. Minutes: **It was moved by Weber and seconded by Miller to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of Wednesday, February 14. MC**

Bridges will be inspected on road check and if any questions, will contact County to also inspect.
