Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:05 pm on Wednesday, August 8, 2018 at the Town Hall in Downsville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, Dennis Weber, John Miller, Sally Rasmussen and Arlene Cartwright, Sheriff Candidate Kevin Bygd

1. Minutes: **It was moved by Weber and seconded by Miller to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of Wednesday, July 11, 2018. MC**
