REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
January 11, 2024

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:08 pm on Wednesday, January 10, 2024 at the Town Hall at N2713 State Road 25, Menomonie. 1. Meeting Minutes: **It was moved by Stalter and seconded by Walker to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of Wednesday, December 13, 2023**
2. Public Comment: Mitch Kruetzer spoke about the alleys in the town getting clogged, Washer and Dryers left sitting, and Unregistered vehicles sitting for years. He stated that these issues are making the Downsview Community look like a junk. Josh Johnson spoke about his alley behind home that used to be an easement and it is being clogged with junk vehicles.
