REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
October 12, 2022

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, October 12, 2022 at the Town Hall in Downs ville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, Dennis Weber, John Stalter, Arlene Cartwright and Sally Rasmussen. Town Citizens: Kelly and Bundy, Tim Lienau, Andy Rabideau and Ann Bates

1. Meeting Minutes: **It was moved by Stalter and seconded by Weber to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of September 14, 2022 and September 20, 2022.**
