1. Minutes: **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Stalter to approve the October 13, 2021 Town of Dunn regular meeting minutes. MC**
2. Public Comment: None
3. Ron Meyer Assessor: the state raised the assessment 11% last year from the year before. The houses are selling for about 60% more than they did in 2020. The 3-year process to do a reevaluation will be about \$45,000. The board needs to decide if they want a reevaluation 2022 or in 2023. Tabled until December.
4. ARPA Funding Update: Waiting to hear from Downsville Sanitary District on their needs. Working on getting election officials back pay for hazard pay. Tables until next month.
5. Treasurer's Report: **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Stalter to approve the October Treasurer's report. MC**
6. Vouchers: The November vouchers were approved as submitted for payment.
7. Bartender License: **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by Forrest Johnson to accept Maggie Anne Wyss for bartender License for the Timber Inn LLC. MC**
8. Museum Meeting: Joshua Foust wants to be on board, but is not a taxpayer of the Town of Dunn, so is disqualified. He did fix the Roof. Jeanette Daines is interested to be on the board. The museum had over 200 kids for the Halloween Day.
9. Welch Update: The placard has been placed on the building. There is still activity at the building.
10. Road Maintenance Report: Crack Filling is done. Mowing is commencing.
11. Equipment Report: Elmer will not start unless pulled.
12. Fire Report: New Tender Water Truck is coming and ordered. Burning permits are now online at the Menomonie Fire Department. They do not want calls anymore. The Fire Department wants the Towns to start charging for Permits.
