Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the regular Town Board Meeting immediately following the special town meeting. Patrolman: John Jacobson, Surveyor: Steve Kochaver

1. Minutes: **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Miller to approve the October 10, 2018 Town of Dunn regular meeting minutes. Forrest Johnson made it unanimous. MC**
2. Treasurer's Report: **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Miller to approve the October Treasurer's report. Forrest Johnson made it unanimous. MC**
3. Vouchers: The November vouchers were approved as submitted for payment.
4. Public Comment: Weber was asked by Jason Bundy to look into an issue with town resident George Welch. It was determined that the Town had no legal means to get involved with the issue.
5. Plan Commission Report: Steve Kochaver asked for a special exemption for green space for the Jerene Price Subdivision. Miller made a motion to approve the Price survey map with the special exemption for green space.
6. Humane Society Contract: Contract was postponed until next meeting
7. Museum Update – The post office move is delayed until Spring. The museum is hosting Pictures with Santa on December 1st. The museum will be closed for the season after Santa is done.
8. Town Hall update. Forrest Johnson stated the lessee from last year will lease again this year. If the Old Town Hall lights are raised, the lessee will pay more. John Jacobson said he could raise the lights. Lessee wants to move in by December 5th.

9. Road Maintenance Report: The Town of Dunn and the Town of Menomonie are jointly mowing the towns. They joint job is about half way done. The shed now has over 1,000 tons of salt/sand in it.
10. Equipment Report: Mower has new tires.
11. Tax Collector Bond: The Town went with the Horton Group, which was \$400 cheaper than Rural.
12. Weber Inspection Renewal Contract: If was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Miller to approve the 2019 contract for Fred Weber Inspections. Johnson made it unanimous. MC
13. Inspection report: Pember final inspection passed, Szalai passed, Gruber passed, Price passed
14. Fire Report: Grain Bin at Marty Mellenthin, Sinz house burned down.
15. Upcoming Meetings and Classes: Solid Waster permits will be enforced on January 1, 2019. Rotary Club is picking up old bikes and fixing them for the needy. WTA raised the dues \$25. Pictures of the fires were presented. The foreclosure notices were read. They were Acer, Gordy Wolf, Margaret Oldroyd/Craig Dilts and Gale Reinecke. 2 MFL transfers were read.
