Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the regular Town Board Meeting immediately following the special town meeting. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, Dennis Weber, John Stalter, Arlene Cartwright and Sally Rasmussen. Town Citizen: Nicole Johnson, Amy Stalter, Kathy Ruggles, John Thomas and Brian Shefchik. Surveyor: Ron Jasperson

1. Minutes: Correct mobile home to motor home. **It was moved by John Stalter and seconded by Dennis Weber to approve the Oct 12, 2022 Town of Dunn regular meeting minutes with correction. MC**
2. Thomas Ruggles Subdivision: Ron Jasperson spoke for Kathy and John to split the existing lot that was created by an earlier survey. They are creating a 3-lot survey from 16.9 acres. Lots 5 and 6 will be accessed off of 464<sup>th</sup> street. There will be an easement across Lot 6 to Lot 5. Lot 4 will be accessed off the town road by Hwy 25. The open space is on the dotted spots and the hatching is the slopes. The county has approved the survey. Johnson asked about the curve on 464<sup>th</sup> St. The survey shows the curve, but the road does not. **Dennis Weber made a motion to approve Thomas/Ruggles subdivision. John Stalter Seconded. MC**
3. Shefchik Rezone – Ron Jasperson spoke for Brian Shefchik about the rezone of his property that is currently zoned R2 and wishes to be zoned Commercial. His future plans are to subdivide the properties and sell some to another company. **John Stalter moved to approve the Shefchik Rezone; Dennis Weber seconded. MC**
4. Public Comment: None
5. Treasurer's Report: **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Stalter to approve the October Treasurer's report. MC**
6. Vouchers: The November vouchers were approved as submitted for payment.
7. Bartender License: **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by Forrest Johnson to accept Tyra Collette Petersohn for bartender License for the Timber Inn LLC. MC**
8. **Election Grant** – There is a \$1200 grant available. Several options were presented to the board. The Board decided to go with the security cameras for the building. **It was motioned by John Stalter and seconded by Dennis Weber to approve the Cameras for the Election Security Grant. MC**
9. **Dog Catcher:** The choice between a dog catcher and the Dunn County Humane Society was discussed. **John Stalter made a motion to go with the Dunn County Humane Society. Dennis Weber Seconded. MC**

10. **Welch Property:** An update on the situation was discussed. The Raze Order will go to the next level at the end of November.
11. **Pitt Lake Update:** There was discussion on what to do with a small dip in the concrete that gets standing water. No action will be taken at this time as it is not a big problem.
12. **Sanitary District Update** – None
13. **Museum Meeting:** They are talking about getting 6 exit signs and a fire extinguisher. That is not what was originally in the budget. More discussion needed. Santa will be coming in December
14. **Election Report:** Great election 717 voters were here.
15. **Road Maintenance Report:** Boom Mower rental went well. The State will be starting the Hwy 72 project for 2026.
16. **Equipment Report:** New Grader has arrived. Tractor should be here at end of month
17. **Building Report:** Inspector Report was read
18. **Weber Inspector Contract Renewal: It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Stalter to approve the Weber Inspector for another year. MC**
19. **Fire Report:** No report. Forrest became the VP of the fire board. The tender truck has been delayed 1 year.
