

**TOWN OF DUNN
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
December 9, 2020**

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, December 9, 2020 at the Town Hall in Downsville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, John Miller, Dennis Weber, Sally Rasmussen, and Arlene Cartwright.

1. Minutes: **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Miller to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of Wednesday, November 11, 2020**
