

TOWN OF DUNN
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
February 9, 2022

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, February 9, 2022 at the Town Hall in Downs ville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, John Stalter and Sally Rasmussen. Missing: Arlene Cartwright and Dennis Weber. Town Citizens: John Miller and Mike Hotchkiss Town Patrolman: John Jacobson

1. Meeting Minutes: **It was moved by Stalter and seconded by Johnson to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of January 12, 2022**
2. **Public Comment:** None
3. **Treasurer's Report:** No Report
4. **Vouchers:** The February vouchers were approved for payment
5. **Friedenfel Subdivision/Rezone:** No recommendation from plan commission. Tabled until next month.
6. **Bartender License: Stalter made a motion to accept Grace Elizabeth Strey for bartender license at Cubby's, LLC. Johnson seconded. MC**
7. **Invasive Species:** There are four places in the town that have invasive species: Champion, 330th by Dunn Ridge and County Y. The town board discussed whether the town should contract the county for spraying or try to control with mowing. At this time, the town will table until next month.
8. **Welch Property:** There has been activity and the no living permit has been removed. The water was turned on by an unknown subject and the DSD turned the water back off. John Stalter will follow up with the Health Department for new placards.
9. **Wik's Repair Car Issue:** Forrest took pictures that were entered into the town record. The formal complaint in writing from a business owner was also entered. There has been an ongoing issue with the cars lined up. Mike has more help and has been moving the cars the last week. The town will give Mike more time to clear the area. John Miller added that the patio at Timber Inn pushes the sidewalk out further and then people are parking in the road or illegally on the sidewalk.
10. Spring Primary – The Menomonie School District will be having a primary in February.
11. Pitt Lake Update – Forrest Johnson made a motion to approve the \$150 refund from LRI for the issue with the deposit boxes. John Miller mentioned that the attendants needed more plowing as they had to chip with a blade.
12. Sanitary District: Forrest Johnson went to the meeting and the Sanitary District did not need anything at this time. The pump they were looking at doubled in price. The monitoring system they requested is not needed. The DSD will be doing a study in order to raise the rates. Mitch Kruetzer is a new training service person to replace Ben Topper.
13. Road Maintenance Report – Brush cutting in in process. Forrest asked John Miller if there are any cracks on his road. John has not seen any. John Miller questioned if the town would be doing expansion joints. No decision was made at this time.
14. Equipment Report – The chains were fixed by Universal and there is a \$750 credit at Universal. The grader bids were presented to the town board. **John Stalter made a motion to purchase a new grader from John Deere 672G at \$173,876.54 with trade in. Forrest Johnson seconded. MC**
15. Inspectors Report – The inspector report was read.

17. Correspondence: Farrell Open House, WTA classes, MG lighting, thank you cards from Jeanette Daines (Jim Daines Obit) and Sarah Jacobson Family. EEW put 40 acres into Managed Forrest.
