

TOWN OF DUNN
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
February 12, 2020

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, February 12, 2020 at the Town Hall in Downsville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, Dennis Weber, John Miller, and Sally Rasmussen, Arlene Cartwright. Surveyor: Ron Jaspersen ATV Coordinator: Lucas Bracken, Town Citizen: Sarah Broadfoot

1. Minutes: **It was moved by Weber and seconded by Miller to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of Wednesday, January 8, 2020**
2. Treasurer's Report: **It was moved by Weber and seconded by Miller to approve the January Treasurer's report. MC**
3. Vouchers: The February vouchers were approved for payment
4. Public Comment: Lucas Bracken, Assistant trail coordinator spoke for the Dunn County ATV Club: Jeff Schroader is trail coordinator. The county is requesting one ordinance for Dunn County instead of individual town ordinances. This would be helpful for police and tourists. Contact information is Eric Schultz at 715-410-8761
5. Ruggles/Thomas Subdivision: Ron Jaspersen – surveyor spoke for Ruggles/Thomas about the subdivision. The plan commission passed the subdivision to the town before an out lot was added by the county for the land that was divided by the road. Tom Carlson spoke to Chairman Johnson about the out lot. **It was moved by Weber and seconded by Miller to approve the subdivision for Thomas/Ruggles. All favor. MC**
6. Garage Set Back: Ron Jaspersen spoke for Broadfoot/Thomas/Ruggles about the setback for the garage that they want on their newly subdivided land. The garage is 4.3 feet from the road right away. The county still has to approve the setback. **It was moved by Weber and seconded by Miller to approve the set back at 7 feet instead of 4.3 feet from road right away for the garage. All in favor. MC**
7. Nitrate Results: Weber and Johnson were tested. There will be a second-round next month to determine if the nitrate results that were high came from Animals or people.
8. Fishing Contest Request: Fishing contest is 2-23-2020. **It was moved by Weber and seconded by Miller to approve the Class B picnic license. All in favor. MC**
9. Cubby's Bartender License: **It was moved by Miller and seconded by Weber to approve the bartender license for Melissa Petrouske. All in Favor. MC**
10. Museum Meeting: Eau Claire insulation checked out Museum. The budget was approved.
11. Town Hall Rental Update – The town will be searching for a cleaning person.
12. Patrolman Retirement Update – Dennis tried to call Edward Jones. No contact yet. Tabled for future town board meeting.
13. Road Maintenance Report – There is a dip in the road on Stokke Road. Highway 25 is going to be repaved this year by the State of Wisconsin

Equipment Report – The town board was presented a price list for the extended warranty for the new plow truck. **Miller made a motion to approve the purchase of extended warranty for both the protection plan and after treatment coverage for a total of \$3,090.00. Weber seconded. All in Favor. MC**
