REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
February 12, 2025

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, February 12, 2025 at the Town Hall at N2713 State Road 25, Menomonie. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, John Stalter, Kaley Walker and Sally Rasmussen, Town Citizen: Todd Edwards, Danielle and Paul Rosolack, Brad Ullom

1. Meeting Minutes: **It was moved by Stalter and seconded by Walker to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of Wednesday, January 8th, 2025**
2. Public Comment: Town Citizens Elden Larsen and Joyce Reuter passed away.
3. Treasurer's Report: Kaley Walker made a motion to accept the December 2024 Treasurers report. Stalter seconded. MC
4. Vouchers: The February vouchers were approved for payment
5. Dog Boarding – Danielle spoke about her proposed 1200 square feet building on their property to house 10 dogs. There will not be a play area for multiple dogs, but there will be a play area for separate dogs. They will be tied into the existing sewer and water system for washing dogs, but no dog grooming. There is no time limit on the length of stay. There will be a public hearing on February 17th for a special exception. **Stalter made motion to approve the special exception for the Commercial Dog Kennel. Walker seconded. MC.**
6. Fishing License: **Kaley walker made a motion to approve the fishing contest. Johnson seconded. Stalter abstained. MC**
7. Schedule of Fees: The schedule of fees was presented to the board. Walker made a motion to approve the schedule of fees and citations. Stalter seconded. MC
8. Spring Primary: Spring Primary will be next week, February 18th for State Superintendent of Public Instruction.
9. Pitt Lake Update: There was a verbal altercation with a Weston resident about not having a dump pass. Gavin Styer, Town of Weston board member contacted Town of Dunn about long lines.
10. Sanitary District Update – Water Tower sprung a leak. Fire Hydrant was running to alleviate the Tower pressure. They are looking into grants.
11. Road Maintenance Report – The Dunn County Roads were listed. The price of Salt/Sand has increased. **Walker made a motion to accept the ARIP Grant. Stalter seconded. MC**
12. Equipment Report – Plow Truck is in Eau Claire and has not been sent to Universal yet.
13. Building Inspectors Report – The inspector report was read. Fred Weber called Forrest about the new ADU in Downsville. Tammy Traxler took the position head zoning officer.
14. Fire Report: Forrest talked to Denny Klass, Fire Chief, about the oven fire at Elden Larson's. The oven fire inside a house is a big deal, so they sent everyone. The firemen

were out on another call, so they had to call people in and pay them overtime. Next fire meeting is Feb 25th.
