3. Vouchers: The march vouchers were approved for payment
4. Public Comment: None
5. Subdivision: Leonard/Kochaver – The plan commission reviewed the subdivision for the Leonard subdivision and forwarded it to the Town board with their approval: **Dennis Weber made a motion to approve the subdivision for the Leonard Subdivision. John Stalter seconded. MC**
6. Subdivision: Jasperson/Mellenthin - The plan commission reviewed the subdivision for the Mellenthin subdivision and forwarded it to the Town board with their approval: **Dennis Weber made a motion to approve the subdivision for the Mellenthin Subdivision. John Stalter seconded. MC** Jasperson gave update on Kistner Property. The Kistner subdivision will be on April agenda for both Plan Commission and Town Board
7. ATV Club Presentation: ATV gave a presentation for the ATV. They wish to have 365 days a year and 24 hours. The town has 365 days a year, but not 24 hours. The ATV club says that more towns are going 24 hours a day and they are asking Town of Dunn to do the same. Jeff states that if the ATV club can get all the towns on the same page, the police will be more on board to enforce the rules if they are consistent. No police were at meeting to agree or dispute this claim.
8. Insurance Quote: Thompson Insurance agent Karen Saxe: Karen presented three quotes. They were the same except for the museum. The three quotes are put into the insurance folder with the current policy from Rural. The quotes were cheaper than the current Rural Insurance policy with more benefits.
