

**TOWN OF DUNN – DUNN COUNTY**  
**REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**  
**March 11, 2026**

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, March 11, 2026 at the Town Hall at N2713 State Road 25, Menomonie. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, Brad Ullom, Kaley Walker, Arlene Cartwright and Sally Rasmussen Auth Survey Technician: Sam Erickson

1. Meeting Minutes: **It was moved by Walker and seconded by Ullom to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of Wednesday, February 11, 2026**
2. Public Comment:
3. Ron Weisenbeck Subdivision: Ron and Kelly are splitting out 12.79-acre wooded parcel from a 29.95-acre square. There is 6.35-acre green space. There is an existing old syrup shack on the land that has not been used for years. There is not a driveway access to the 838.62-foot easement to the lot from the County at this time to County Road DD from the existing property. There is a permit pending. There is a field access at this time on County Road DD. **Kaley Walker made a motion to approve the subdivision for Ron Weisenbeck with encouragement to complete the Dunn County Driveway Permit process. Brad Ullom seconded. All in favor. MC UPDATE: 3/12/2026 Driveway Permit was signed and sent to town.**
4. Treasurer's Report: Partial treasurers report was read by treasurer and the full treasurer's report will be up for approval next month.
5. Vouchers: The March vouchers were approved for payment
6. Pitt Lake Update – A 7 plex owner is using the dump and they have a pass. As long as they have a pass, they are allowed to come there. Teresa was at dump 1 hour last month and looked at the compactors and how they run to make SOP for them. She is making an SOP for Pressure readings.
7. Downsville Sanitary District – A new water tower is 5 million dollars and a fix on the water tower would be about a half a million dollars. They are pursuing a grant to fix the water tower.
8. Annual Meeting – A cheese/meat tray and water will be served. Agendas will be posted in 3 places in the town and on the website.
9. Cemetery mowing bid – Mowing bid will be posted at bank, post office, town hall and put on the website.
10. Zoning update – 1) Kelly Bolton has inquired about a driveway permit and a shed. There is some dispute/discussion on whether he owns the land or Gerald Smith's son Blaise own the land. 2) Zack Leach's Driveway Permit is still pending. 3) A driveway was put on 330<sup>th</sup> Avenue and there is no permit. The town chairman will be pursuing this development. 4) The Brownell family purchased the land to the west of the Town Hall. They are looking to get a residential driveway permit to build a home and a cabin with a shed on that land. 5) Melverna will be going into treatment. She has not contacted town of Inspector for building permit. April 10<sup>th</sup> is her 2-year deadline to

get mobile home moved into place. 6) Dunn Ridge Association is delinquent with their taxes.

11. Road Maintenance Report – Road bans went on Thursday, March 5<sup>th</sup>. Brad Ullom will be finding out if the Town will pursue a culvert grant.
12. Road Maintenance report – A sign on 330<sup>th</sup> was replaced. It had a rotted post. An Arrow sign was chain sawed off the post and stolen on the corner of 600<sup>th</sup> and 210<sup>th</sup>.
13. Set Road Inspector Report – The Road Inspection will be Wednesday, April 8<sup>th</sup> 7-Noon.
14. Equipment Report – Time for new tractor. Equipment list was distributed. New Plow truck came with bad air bg.
15. Building Inspectors Report – None
16. Fire Report: The New Fire Truck has arrived and pictures were filed in with fire bills. An innovation grant will be talked about at the next Rural Fire meeting.
17. Set Board of Review Date – Board of Review will be on Wednesday, May 13<sup>th</sup> from 5-7 pm. Open Book will be the previous Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup> from 5-7 pm.
