

TOWN OF DUNN
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
June 10, 2020

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, June 10, 2020 at the Town Hall in Downsville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, John Miller, Dennis Weber, Sally Rasmussen, and Arlene Cartwright. Town Citizen: Marty Mellenthin Menomonie Disposal: Claire Reusch, Travis Stokes Surveyor: Ron Jasperson Wisconsin Rural Water Association (WRWA): Andrew Aslesen

1. Minutes: **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Miller to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of Wednesday, May 13, 2020**
2. Treasurer's Report: **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Miller to approve the May Treasurer's report. MC**
3. Vouchers: The June vouchers were approved for payment
4. Public Comment:
5. Mellenthin Subdivision: Ron Jasperson presented the Mellenthin Subdivision. It is a 4.87-acre subdivision out of an 80 acres land plot on Hwy 25. The Plan Commission previewed the subdivision and approved it to come to the board. **It was moved by Dennis Weber and seconded by John Miller to approve the subdivision presented with no changes. MC**
6. ORD 2020-01 Well Protection Ordinance: Andrew is source water specialist and specialist in geology. He works with municipalities to figure out where their groundwater comes from and to protect the groundwater. The WRWA asked if the DSD had a wellhead ordinance. It takes the area that you have identified for groundwater and puts zoning in the area to protect the drinking water. Andrew put together Ordinance for the board to review. Question from Chairman: In Section 5: Prohibited Uses lists cemeteries. There is currently a cemetery within the zoning area. Andrew stated the current cemetery would be grandfathered in, but if the cemetery expanded the land, it would need to be addressed. Question was asked by town resident about wells near the Wellhead. Drilling of new wells are approved by DNR, not WRWA. The board will look at the ordinance and it will be on the July agenda for further review.
7. Solid Waste and Recycling: Claire spoke for the Menomonie Disposal. She presented the board with two proposals. One is to have a drop off site and the other is curbside collection. Items like Vehicle items, Appliances, and electronics are an extra cost. They will not pick up yard waste. The board will revisit in July.
8. License Renewal: The license renewals were read. All licenses were read. All payments were made and were good. **Dennis Weber made a motion to approve the liquor license to Jeremiah's Bullfrog Fish Farm, LLC, Cubby's, LLC, The Timber Inn, LLC and Creamery, LLC. John Miller seconded. All in favor. MC**
9. ATV Uniform Ordinance Update: Three questions were asked of the board for the future WTA meeting vote: The board agreed unanimously to stick with current ordinance choices. First is Dates for ATV/UTV on Roads: April 1st through December 1st each year. Second is Speed limits for ATVs/UTVs: 35 mph. Third was Hours for ATV/UTV on roads: The choice as One hour before dawn though one hour after dusk or 24 hours per

day. The board wished to have 7 am to 10 pm. Much more effective than dusk to dawn. Not 24 hours. Answers were sent to WTA.

10. NCRS Update: The town residents asked for a reduction in the height of the weir. The NCRS said they would like to get the culverts dry by digging ditches to enhance the flowage in the area. It was mentioned by John Ohman that 17 feet over a mile could be a slope of less than ¼ percent slope though grass. Meeting minutes postponed until July Meeting.
11. Museum update: Pancake Breakfast is cancelled.
12. Equipment Report: New Truck was painted.
13. Road Maintenance Report: Waiting for pulverizer for road. The town will be doing about \$1,000 of work for DNR on Larrabee Road
14. Inspectors Report: The inspector report was read
15. Fire Report: Power Pole Fire and Fire alarm. Pin Report Read.
16. Correspondence: Denise, Dawn and John Hase are out of compliance for mobile home. Josephina is out of compliance. Forrest responded to two garbage complaints in town. Both were resolved after the Town Dump was reopened after a two month shut down.

It was moved by Weber and seconded by Miller to adjourn. MC. Meeting adjourned at 8:49 pm. MC
