REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
June 8, 2022

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, June 8, 2022 at the Town Hall in Downsville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, Dennis Weber, John Stalter, Arlene Cartwright and Sally Rasmussen. Cemetery Consultant and Sexton: Patrick Thibado

1. Meeting Minutes: **It was moved by Weber and seconded by Stalter to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of May 11, 2022**
2. **Public Comment:** Patrick Thibado spoke about how he is the sexton for other cemeteries. He finds out where the people are buried and he knows the laws and rules of the cemeteries. The clerk approached him to find out where the people were buried in the Pawnell Cemetery. He stated the he has researched some people in the cemetery and has an interest in it and would like to help the town find out where people are buried. He also spoke of some of the residents that are currently in the cemetery. If the board agrees, he would like to do some probing of the cemetery to map Pawnell cemetery and find out if there are any buried headstones. This will be put in the next meeting agenda.

5. **Liquor License:** The liquor licenses and bartender licenses were presented to the board for the 2022/23 licensing season. There are 5 business requests for licenses. The details can be found in the town records and online at the Department of Revenue Website. **Dennis Weber made a motion to approve the liquor licenses for Cubby's, Inc, Jeremiahs Bullfrog Fish Farm, Scatterbrain Café, LLC, The Creamery, LLC and The Timber Inn, LLC . 6. **Pitt Lake Passes:** Kayle Sue Walker asked to have her passes reduced from 2 to 1. **John Stalter made a motion to table the pass until Kayle Walker contacts Ron to inspect property for a determination. If not inspected by August, the passes will stay at two. Weber seconded. All approved. MC**
7. **Welch Property:** An update was given by zoning.
8. **Pitt Lake:** Nothing
9. **Sanitary District Update:** They are mowing their own lawn.
10. **Museum Meeting:** Pancake Breakfast was a hit.
11. **Pitt Lake Update:** No Update
12. **Road Maintenance:** 290th is getting paved today.
13. **Equipment Report:** Elmer has been sold. Boiler was inspected.
14. **Cold Storage Shed:** The board decided that the placement of the building would be good between the salt/sand shed and fuel barrels. It will be a 40X40 building.
