

**TOWN OF DUNN**  
**REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**  
**July 14, 2021**

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, July 14, 2021 at the Town Hall in Downsville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, Dennis Weber, John Stalter, Sally Rasmussen, and Arlene Cartwright. West Wisconsin Telcom Representative: Brad Schmidtknecht

1. Minutes: **It was moved by Weber and seconded by Stalter to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of Wednesday, June 9, 2021 with the correction of Hintzman instead of Hendrickson. MC**
2. Treasurer's Report: **It was moved by Weber and seconded by Stalter to approve the June Treasurer's report. MC**
3. Vouchers: The July vouchers were approved for payment
4. Public Comment: No comment
5. West Wisconsin Telcom: Brad spoke for the Telcom to ask the town for the ARPA grant money to expand WWT in the town. Currently, he stated there is 134 Households without WWT, but may have Charter or AT&T service. The clerk will research how many people have no internet. Discussion and decision tabled.

7. Dog License: It was discussed to increase the dog license fees for the town. After some discussion, the town decided to create a resolution in the next meeting for an increase in dog licenses to \$5, \$10 and \$40 from \$3, \$8 and \$35.
8. Pitt Lake Collection Site: The attendants complained about the puddle on the concrete during rainstorms. The town discussed the puddle and decided the attendant's need to use a broom. An extension to the dog kennel was purchased and installed for tires.
9. Museum Update: The tuck pointing is close to being finished. After moving the sign on the trail, the committee members got poison ivy. Donations were received. There will be a quilt silent auction.
10. Bridge Petition: Two Bridge petitions were discussed for 630<sup>th</sup> Street. **John Stalter made a motion to approve the two bridge petitions, Dennis Weber seconded. All signed. MC**
11. Road Maintenance Report – 630<sup>th</sup> and 290<sup>th</sup> have the first layer of black top on.
12. Equipment Report – Freightliner is in the shop for a loose rear end that is taking out air bags. All warrantied and River States is asking Universal to pay for the issue.
