

**TOWN OF DUNN**  
**REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**  
**August 10, 2022**

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, August 10, 2022 at the Town Hall in Downsville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, Dennis Weber, John Stalter, Arlene Cartwright and Sally Rasmussen.

1. **Meeting Minutes: It was moved by Weber and seconded by Stalter to approve the regular Town Board meeting minutes of July 13, 2022**
2. **Public Comment:** None
3. **Treasurer's Report: Weber made a motion to approve the July Treasurer's Report, Stalter Seconded. MC**
4. **Vouchers:** The August vouchers were approved for payment
5. **Kaley Sue Walker:** The board decided to continue to charge 2 dump passes for this residence. Forrest will call.
6. **Update Town Hall Rental Contract:** As of January 2023, the new town hall prices will be \$100 for intown rental and \$150 for out of town with a \$100 deposit. **John Stalter made a motion to approve the changes. Dennis Weber seconded. MC**
7. **Update Bartender Licenses:** As of January 1, 2023, the price for Bartender licenses will go from \$7 to \$10. **Dennis Weber made a motion to approve the increase in price. John Stalter seconded. MC**
8. **Increase in Plan Commission Pay.** As of January 1, 2023, the Plan Commission Pay will be increased from \$15 per meeting to \$20 per meeting. **Dennis Weber made a motion to approve the increase in Plan Commission pay from \$15 to \$20. John Stalter seconded. MC**
9. **Welch Property:** The inspector and lawyer were contacted for the 1<sup>st</sup> part of razing the building.
10. **Pitt Lake Update:** New Compactor will be arriving soon. The DNR did their first inspection.
11. **Sanitary District Update:** No update
12. **LP Gas Pricing:** Thaler came in with the lowest bid at \$1.87 and they guaranteed a lower price if market went lower. **Dennis Weber made a motion to accept the contract for Thaler oil, John Stalter seconded. MC**
13. **Museum Meeting:** Downsville Day Pancake Breakfast. A fire inspection was made and the need a fire extinguisher and Exit Signs.
14. **Road Maintenance:** Mowing is in progress. No progress on parking lot.
15. **Equipment Report:** Forrest and Dennis will be talking to another chairman to possibly work on sharing a boom mower.
16. **Building Inspectors Report:** Reports were read.
17. **Fire Report:** John Creaser had a fire on the side of the road. Report read
18. **Chairman Report:** There is a fence dispute on Deer Trail
