REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
September 14, 2022

Chairman Forrest Johnson opened the Town of Dunn Board meeting at 7:06 pm on Wednesday, September 14, 2022 at the Town Hall in Downsville. Board members present: Forrest Johnson, Dennis Weber, John Stalter, Arlene Cartwright and Sally Rasmussen.
