

**TOWN OF DUNN**

**RES. #2011-03  
TO ADOPT REVISED SUPERVISORY DISTRICTS & WARD  
PLAN WITH 2010 CENSUS**

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes requires all cities, villages and towns with a population of 1,000 or more to establish municipal wards based on the results of the 2010 federal census.

WHEREAS, these laws require that each municipality designate a geographic description of the various wards to be created within the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE Town of Dunn adopts the wards described as follows:

**District 28 =Ward #1: That part of the Town of Dunn EAST of the Red Cedar River.  
District 29 =Ward #2: That part of the Town of Dunn WEST of the Red Cedar River.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Wards 1 and 2 created above are hereby combined for voting purposes so as to share the common polling place, and such combined wards shall use common ballot boxes and ballots and shall maintain common election returns for the combined wards at any election for which all officers or referendum questions to be voted on are the same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that separate returns shall not be maintained for the combined wards at any election, except where separate ballots are required.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage, a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the town clerk, who shall transmit a copy of the ward plan and this resolution to the County Clerk within five (5) days of its adoption and that this resolution shall remain in effect for each election until modified or rescinded, in accordance with Statute, or until a new division is made following the next federal decennial census.
